Concessions are available for students who are entitled to one of the Centrelink benefits listed below:

To receive a Concession you must:

- > have the Concession applied to your account before your invoice due date

## AND

- > be eligible at the time of enrolment (that is you have proof that you are in receipt of one of the following Centrelink benefits)

## OR

- > Sign a Fee Concession Agreement (Form 168) with CIT to confirm your intention to apply for one of the following Centrelink benefits

Health Care Card (Accepted)	Youth Allowance Newstart (NS)
Health Care Card <b>LI</b> – Low Income (Further proof required)	<b>Recipients must show reporting or payment statement to be granted concession</b>
Veterans' Affairs Children's Education Scheme Allowance	The notification from VACESA advising of successful application of the Long Tan Bursary
Health Care Card <b>SP</b> – Special Benefits (Further proof required)	Check with the Student Services Hub

**Please note:** – a Health Care Card/Pension Card for Sickness Allowance is NOT accepted

**A valid Concession entitles you to 50% off your Program fees and/or Recognition fees only**

Concessions do not apply to:

- > Material fees
- > Excursion fees
- > CITSA services and facilities fees
- > Higher Education fees
- > Programs conducted by CIT Solutions
- > Late fees
- > Administration fees
- > CIT Card replacement fees
- > Apprenticeship/traineeship program fees
- > Degree components of CIT programs
