Statement of Attainment — Introduction to Organisational Cyber Security [extract from 22334VIC]

Overview

This course provides introductory knowledge and skills for cyber security in an organisation. You will learn how to recognise threats, risks and vulnerabilities that affect networks, machines, applications, data, users, and infrastructure.

In addition, it also covers:

- an introduction to common cyber security attack mechanisms
- an introduction to identity and threat management
- security issues surrounding Internet of Things (IOT) devices.

Finally, the course introduces the implementation of tools and systems an organisation can use to protect from cyber-attacks.
