### Professional Placement Enrolment CRN:

**For general students:**

All general students must complete 3 placements in a registered Early Learning Centre to achieve the required 280-hour placement requirement.

**For Workers:**

All workers to complete the 280-hour placement requirement in their workplace with supervisor verification and teacher observations over 3 various visits throughout the completion of the course.

<b>For Trainees:</b>	All trainees will complete the 280-hour placement requirement in their workplace with supervisor verification. As a trainee at CIT, you and your centre will be assigned a trainee mentor to support you through your traineeship. Your trainee mentor will conduct 3 hours of visits over the semester to mentor you and observe your practical skills for assessment purposes.
As per CIT Assessment Policy, the teacher has 2 weeks from submission date to mark your assessment. This also applies to entering grades. Once all assessments are marked Satisfactory, the teacher has 2 weeks to enter your grade.	

## Flexible delivery: Professional Placement and Study Path options

As a self-paced student, you can choose to study at a pace that suits you.  
As part of the requirements for the Diploma qualification, you will need to complete 280hours of professional placement with children in a registered Education and Care service.

The professional placement hours have been divided up to ensure you have adequate time to compete all the required tasks both written and practical for each of the clusters you enrol in.

Please ensure your enrolment in the self-paced units reflects the option you choose below.

- **If you completed the Reflective Practices cluster as part of your Certificate III, then you do not need to enrol again.**
- **It is recommended that you enrol into the clusters in the order below.**

<b>For Trainees:</b>	All trainees will complete the minimum 280-hour placement requirement in their workplace with supervisor verification. Your Trainee Mentor will complete observations in the workplace throughout the semester.
