DECISION ON YOUR ACCESS APPLICATION

I refer to the access application made by and the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (FOI Act) to the ACT Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD). This application was partially transferred to the Canberra Institute of Technology (CIT) on 8 August 2023. In your application you requested the following information which was most likely to be held by the CIT:

- All correspondence and documentation between the CEO of CIT and the Minister for Skills or his staff, surrounding a potential conflict of interest declared between the CEO of CIT's relationship to Think Garden CEO, Patrick Hollingworth and the subsequent contracts awarded to his company.
- All correspondence and documentation between the CEO of CIT, Leanne cover, and the Minister for Skills or his staff, surrounding a potential conflict of interest between the CIT CEO and Patrick Hollingworth for all contracts first executed from 27 July 2017 until 28 March 2022 inclusive of contracted entities: Redrouge, Think Garden and Trustee for the Patrick Hollingworth Family Trust.

Authority

I am a Senior Executive officer appointed as a CIT Information Officer to make decisions about access to government information, in accordance with section 18 of the FOI Act.
