▶ WHO NEEDS TO SUBMIT A PORTFOLIO?

For new applicants planning to study **Diploma of Apparel, Fashion and Textiles** without prior completion of the Certificate III in Apparel, Fashion and Textiles we request that you submit a portfolio of relevant creative work and complete an interview.

▶ HOW DO I BOOK AN INTERVIEW AND SUBMIT MY PORTFOLIO?

Applicants are required to bring their portfolio to the interview.

Before booking an interview, we recommend you put in an application or 'register your interest' for the course through the [CIT website](#).

You will find out during the interview whether you have been accepted into the Diploma.

▶ WHAT SHOULD I INCLUDE IN MY PORTFOLIO?

Portfolio Requirements

To get a better understanding of your current skills we would like you to bring in some examples of your previous work. This could be a portfolio, visual diary, or sewing samples.

We do not expect you to have any experience in fashion prior to starting your course as we offer 2 units of competency that will enable you to pick up the basics in sewing and drawing. The teacher will discuss this with you at your interview.

If you are looking at going straight into the Diploma and not doing the units to pick up the basics, you will need evidence of:

- **Drawings:** This could be observational, experimental, sketching or fashion drawings that show how you have communicated your ideas visually.
- **Sewing:** This could be a sewing sample that shows how you have stitched seams, gathering, tucks, darts etc.

Additional Guidelines

After the interview, we will request that you complete the LNN (Language, Literacy and Numeracy) online assessment. Please note, this a tool for us to assist your learning needs and will **not** impact the results of your interview.
