Our goal is for students to reach their full potential. Support is provided in partnership with students so they may accomplish their chosen goals.

At CIT Yurauna, we provide Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander specific courses, as well as support to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students enrolled in general CIT courses.

- Certificate III in Community Services (CHC32015)


General Education
