



# Concessions

A concession is a 50% reduction on eligible course fees, Skills Recognition fees and the Services and Amenities fee. Concessions are available for students who are receiving or are entitled to one of the Centrelink benefits listed below:

- ▶ ABSTUDY
- ▶ Age Pension
- ▶ Austudy
- ▶ Carer Payment
- ▶ Disability Support Pension
- ▶ Newstart Allowance
- ▶ Parenting Payment (Single)
- ▶ Parenting Payment (Partnered)
- ▶ Widow Allowance
- ▶ Youth Allowance
- ▶ Veteran's Affairs Pension
- ▶ Veteran's Affairs Children's Education Scheme Allowance (VACESA). Recipient must provide the notification from VACESA advising of successful application of the Long Tan Bursary.

Students in receipt of a Special Benefit from Centrelink or *Apprentices* may also be eligible for a concession. Please enquire at any CIT Student Services Shopfront.

In order to have a concession applied to your student account each semester you must:

- ▶ request that your concession be applied to your account **BEFORE** all outstanding fees have been paid, or if you are enrolled in a HELP Loan eligible program, **BEFORE** your first Census Date
- AND**
- ▶ sign the Centrelink Client Consent form (allowing CIT staff to confirm your concession eligibility), **OR**
- ▶ provide current proof you meet the eligibility for a concession.

If your parents are on one of the above benefits and you are listed as a dependant you will also be eligible to receive a 50% fee reduction.

Concessions do not apply to:

- ▶ Materials fees, excursion fees, technology fees and other resourcing fees
- ▶ Fees for Commercial (full fee-paying) subjects/courses
- ▶ Higher Education fees
- ▶ Degree components of CIT programs (regardless of the funding source)
- ▶ Sponsored students (including those from government agencies)
- ▶ Printing and photocopying charges
- ▶ Administration fees
- ▶ CIT Card replacement fee
- ▶ Programs conducted by CIT Solutions
- ▶ International Students
