

Fee Concessions

A Fee Concession (Concession) is a 50% reduction on eligible fees.

Concessions are available to students who are have a current Pensioner Concession Card (PCC), Health Care Card (HCC), Veteran Affairs Pension, or Veteran Affairs Children's Education Scheme Allowance (VACESA).

Students under 18 and listed as a dependent on a parent's card, will also be eligible for a Concession.

Australian Apprentices who do not have a current PCC, HCC or Veteran's Affairs Gold Card may still be eligible by demonstrating they are a low income earner. Please enquire at any CIT Student Services location.

To get a concession, **each semester** students must apply for and have the concession applied **before** the date of their first class. Students will need to provide current proof of meeting the eligibility for a concession and/or complete the Centrelink Client Consent form (allowing CIT staff to confirm your concession eligibility).

Concessions do not apply to:

- Project, excursion, technology and other resource fees
- CIT commercial fees and full fees subjects/courses/programs
- Higher education fees (degree and associate degrees)
- CIT solutions fees
- CIT card replacement fee
- Administration fees
- Printing and photocopying charges
- ▶ Graduation robe hire fee
- Replacement award fee
- Fees of sponsored students (including those from government agencies, funded employment agencies, and public and private employers)
