

## **Proxy Enrolment Form**

A student who is unable to personally attend an enrolment session at CIT may have a proxy attend in their place.

The proxy must provide the following at the enrolment session to be able to enrol on the student's behalf:

- 1. Documents which show that the individual meets the entry requirements for the program.
- 100 points of ID is required.
  Documents supplied must include at least one primary document proving citizenship, a photo ID and identification showing the student's date of birth. To check the list of appropriate documents see the Student ID Check Form on the website at cit.edu.au/current/my\_study/student\_forms
- 3. A signed copy of this form or a letter of authority signed by the student.

**Note:** If original/certified documentation is not available, CIT Student Services / CIT Library will place an ID Hold on the account until proof is provided to any CIT Student Services or CIT Library.
