CIT response to Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

CIT to pause classes until scheduled CIT Easter break (Friday 10 April 2020)

With so much uncertainty surrounding the COVID-19 situation, CIT has made the decision to continue the pause of classes until the scheduled CIT Easter break, **10 April 2020**. CIT will remain open but students are strongly encouraged not to come to campus during this period.

We have written to all students to update them about the extended pause of classes, and we encourage you to discuss this with your apprentice. They have also been advised that wherever possible, CIT's teaching staff are still available and ready to support them.

We continue to follow the advice of the ACT Health Directorate and the Australian Government Department of Health to monitor and respond to developments and ensure the safety and wellbeing of our CIT community including employers that enable the hands-on learning experience of our apprentices, as well as our students and staff.

In response to the disruption caused by the pandemic, CIT teaching staff are focused on reconfiguring long-term alternative training delivery approaches to continue preparing the ACT workforce.

It goes without saying this is a tricky time for all of us. We will continue to keep you informed and remain absolutely committed to doing everything we can to put the health and safety of our CIT community first.
