

# CIT Interior Design – Portfolio Guidelines

### ▶ WHO NEEDS TO SUBMIT A PORTFOLIO?

New applicants planning to study the **Diploma of Interior Design** or **Advanced Diploma of Interior Design** without prior completion of the Certificate IV in Interior Decoration are required to submit a portfolio of relevant creative work and complete an interview, before allowed entry into the program.

### ▶ HOW DO I BOOK AN INTERVIEW AND SUBMIT MY PORTFOLIO?

Applications are required to bring their portfolio to the interview.

Before booking an interview, we recommend you put in an application or ‘register your interest’ for the course through the [CIT website](#).

You will find out during the interview whether you have been accepted into the Diploma or Advanced Diploma.

### Portfolio Requirements

Please bring a digital or physical portfolio which incorporates a variety of creative projects or demonstrates your problem-solving skills. We want to see that you can have an idea and realise a creative project.

You are not required to bring any large scale or 3D models to the interview. Please submit any of these projects as photos in your portfolio.

If you do not have work which relates directly to Interior Design, please bring:

- Art or design projects
- Personal projects
- School/work projects
- Collaborative projects
- Examples/elements of interior design which interest you
