NOTE: In addition to the times outlined in this timetable, the Allied Health Assistant program includes 2x 2 weeks block placements:

- 1x 2-week placement for Physio Assisting; and 1x 2-week placement for Occupational Therapy Assisting.

To be eligible to go on placement students need to successfully complete all assessment criteria from each subject in the Allied Health Assistance program. If you study this program full-time in semester 2 2022, this will mean you would be eligible to go on placement in semester 1 2023.
