



ACT Australian Apprentice Completion Payment

ACT Australian Apprentices/Trainees may be eligible for a completion payment from the ACT Government if they have:

- ▶ successfully completed the qualification and commenced on or after 1 January 2016
- ▶ not achieved more than 50% of the units through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)
- ▶ completed a student survey sent by Skills Canberra

The completion payment is \$300 for each qualification.

Eligible ACT Australian Apprentices/Trainees are able to receive the completion payment for up to one (1) year after successful completion of the qualification. If eligible, payment will be paid directly to the apprentice/trainee upon completion of the qualification and a student survey. For payment to be successful, apprentices/trainees must lodge their up to date email and bank details via the AVETARS student portal.
