

## English Language Application Process

---

### Step 1: Apply for the course you wish to study

- **Certificate I in Spoken and Written English 10727NAT**: If you can make simple material purchases or give predictable information about self or immediate others.
- **Certificate II in Spoken and Written English 10728NAT**: If you can communicate simple routine needs and provide basic details of less predictable occurrences in vocational situations; can make introductions, give basic biographical information and convey simple intentions or attitudes in social situations.
- **Certificate III in Spoken and Written English 10729NAT**: If you can confidently satisfy basic social needs and routine situations in social, transactional and basic vocational fields.
- **Certificate IV in Spoken and Written English for Further Study 10730NAT**: If you can perform effectively in a wide range of informal and formal situations pertinent to social and community life and everyday commerce and recreation, and in situations which are not linguistically demanding in own 'vocational' fields.

### Step 2: Complete your online application

- Refer to the **how to apply for a CIT course instructions**
- If you are not a permanent resident, please complete a '**Register your Interest**' **form**.  
(Please state your **Visa subclass number** and a **course you wish to study** in the '**Comments**' section)
- An invitation to a placement test will be emailed to you a few weeks prior to the commencement of the course.

### Step 3: Take a placement test

- An ID Check, writing and speaking tests are involved.
- Please allow 90 minutes to complete your placement test.

### Step 4: Complete your online enrolment

- Refer to the **how to enrol in a subject instructions**.
- The appropriate Course Reference Numbers (CRN) will be given to you based on your test results.
