Steps to enrol

1. Check the timetable and subject information for your chosen course

• Read the information and decide if the course is good for you

2. Apply for the course

• Complete an <u>online application</u>

A few weeks before classes begin, we will email you an invitation to do a placement test If you have any problems applying online, contact <u>Student Services</u>

3. Come to CIT to do the placement test

• Bring a minimum of 100 points of ID (passport, visa AND Australian driver's licence)

You will complete a speaking, reading, and writing test. It takes approximately 90 minutes. After the test, a teacher will give you the class information and Course Reference Numbers (CRNs) for enrolment.

4. Enrol in your class
