Step 1: Check the timetable and subject information for your chosen course

Step 2: Tell us if you want to do a Placement Test

- Complete an [online application](#)
- A few weeks before your class begins, we will email you and this email will be an invitation to do a placement test
- If you have any problems applying online, contact [Student Services](#) for help

Step 3: Come to CIT to do the Placement Test

- Bring a minimum of [100 points of ID](#) (for example, your passport, visa AND Australian driver's licence)
- You will do a speaking, reading & writing test and this will take about 90 minutes
- After the test, a teacher will give you information about your classes and some Course Reference Numbers (CRN) you need to enrol
