► WHO NEEDS TO SUBMIT A PORTFOLIO?

For new applicants planning to study **Diploma of Apparel, Fashion and Textiles,** we request that you submit a portfolio of relevant creative work and complete an interview. If completed the Certificate III in Apparel, Fashion and Textiles, no interview required.

► HOW DO I BOOK AN INTERVIEW AND SUBMIT MY PORTFOLIO?

Applicants are required to bring their portfolio to the interview.

Before booking an interview, we recommend you put in an application or 'register your interest' for the course through the <u>CIT website</u>.

You will find out during the interview whether you have been accepted into the Diploma.

How to Book

Bookings are essential. To book an interview, please complete the online **Fashion Interview Booking Form** here: https://forms.office.com/r/0L8K2tPxaP or scan the QR code.

Interviews are generally held on Friday mornings, with each session lasting approximately 20-30 minutes. After you have booked your interview, we will send you a confirmation email with the date, time, and location.

► WHAT SHOULD I INCLUDE IN MY PORTFOLIO?

Portfolio Requirements

We would like to see your current skills. We do not expect you to have any experience in fashion prior to starting your course as we offer 2 units of competency that will enable you to pick up the basics in sewing and drawing. The teacher will discuss this with you at your interview.

If you are looking at going straight into the Diploma and not doing either or both prerequisite units, you will need to bring the following to your interview:

- **Fashion Communications:** Please bring in a maximum of 3 drawings that you have completed. One must be hand drawn.
- **Industrial Sewing:** You need to be able to operate an industrial sewing lock stitch machine, overlocker and iron. You need to show 2 garments that you have sewn.



Additional Guidelines

Before or after the interview, we will request that you complete the LLN (Language, Literacy and Numeracy) online assessment. Please note, this a tool for us to assist your learning needs and will **not** impact the results of your interview.
