

CIT Interior Design – Portfolio Guidelines

► WHO NEEDS TO SUBMIT A PORTFOLIO?

New applicants planning to study the **Diploma of Interior Design** or **Advanced Diploma of Interior Design** without prior completion of the Certificate IV in Interior Decoration are required to submit a portfolio of relevant creative work and complete an interview, before allowed entry into the program. Alternatively, students can commence the Certificate IV in Interior Decoration at the beginning of 2027, and then continue into Diploma and Advanced Diploma of Interior Design.

► HOW DO I BOOK AN INTERVIEW AND SUBMIT MY PORTFOLIO?

Applications are required to bring their portfolio to the interview.

Before booking an interview, we recommend you put in an application or 'register your interest' for the course through the [CIT website](#).

You will find out during the interview whether you have been accepted into the Diploma or Advanced Diploma of Interior Design.

► WHAT SHOULD I INCLUDE IN MY PORTFOLIO?

Portfolio Requirements

For your interview, please bring a couple of creative examples to share with us. These might include:

- A couple of hand drawings, if you have them.
- A moodboard that shows the types of design styles you like.
- Any previous work from school, employment, or personal projects related to interior design or architecture.

If you do not have a full portfolio related to interior design or architecture, please bring any of your creative projects to demonstrate your problem-solving skills.

Additional Guidelines

To meet the **ASQA LLND requirement**, applicants are required to complete the **LLN Quiz** before enrolment. Before or after the interview, we will request that you complete the LLN (Language, Literacy and Numeracy) online assessment if you have not already done so.

Prospective students are considered to have satisfied the LLN requirement where they:

- Have previously completed the LLN quiz with the appropriate ACSF level;
- Hold an equivalent or higher AQF qualification; or
- Are continuing along an approved study pathway (e.g. Certificate IV to Diploma).

If you hold an equivalent or higher AQF qualification, please email us a copy of your academic document for an exemption.
