

CIT Interior Design – Portfolio Guidelines

► WHO NEEDS TO SUBMIT A PORTFOLIO?

New applicants planning to study the **Diploma of Interior Design** or **Advanced Diploma of Interior Design** without prior completion of the Certificate IV in Interior Decoration are required to submit a portfolio of relevant creative work and complete an interview, before allowed entry into the program. Alternatively, students can commence the Certificate IV in Interior Decoration at the beginning of 2026, and then continue into Diploma and Advanced Diploma of Interior Design.

► HOW DO I BOOK AN INTERVIEW AND SUBMIT MY PORTFOLIO?

Applications are required to bring their portfolio to the interview.

Before booking an interview, we recommend you put in an application or 'register your interest' for the course through the <u>CIT website</u>.

You will find out during the interview whether you have been accepted into the Diploma or Advanced Diploma.

Portfolio Requirements

For your interview, please bring a couple of creative examples to share with us. These might include:

- A couple of hand drawings, if you have them.
- A moodboard that shows the types of design styles you like.
- Any previous work from school, employment, or personal projects related to interior design or architecture.

If you do not have a full portfolio related to interior design or architecture, please bring any of your creative projects to demonstrate your problem-solving skills.
