Step 1: Read the subject information for your chosen course

Course in EAL 22637VIC: For Beginner-Level Learners

Certificate I in EAL (Access) 22638VIC: For Elementary-Level Learners

Certificate II in EAL (Access) 22639VIC: For Pre-Intermediate Level Learners

Certificate III in EAL (Access) 22640VIC: For Intermediate / Upper-Intermediate Level Learners

Certificate IV in EAL (Further Study) 22646VIC: For Advanced-Level Learners

Step 2: Tell us if you want to do a Placement Test

- Complete an online application
- A few weeks before your class begins, we will email you and this email will be an invitation to do a placement test
- If you have any problems applying online, contact Student Services for help

Step 3: Come to CIT to do the Placement Test

- Bring a minimum of <u>100 points of ID</u> (for example, your passport, visa AND Australian driver's licence)
- You will do a speaking, reading & writing test and this will take about 90 minutes
- After the test, a teacher will give you information about your classes and some Course Reference Numbers (CRN) you need to enrol
