

## FEE-HELP 2011

#### What is FEE-HELP?

FEE-HELP is a loan scheme that assists eligible fee paying students to pay their tuition fees for degree units (subjects). You repay the loan through the Australian taxation system once your income goes above the designated threshold (\$44,911 in 2011). Over your lifetime you can borrow only up to the FEE-HELP limit, which is indexed each year (e.g. in 2011, the FEE-HELP limit is \$86,422).

A loan fee of 25% (as at 2011) is charged by the Commonwealth Government. The loan fee is also repaid through the Australian Taxation System (e.g. if your Tuition Fee is \$1,000, the loan fee is \$250).

### Who can apply for FEE-HELP?

If you are an **Australian citizen** or **Permanent Humanitarian Visa** holder, you may be eligible for
Commonwealth assistance through FEE-HELP. FEE-HELP is
not available for international students, New Zealand citizens,
all permanent residents, temporary or provisional visa
holders.

#### What does FEE-HELP apply to?

FEE-HELP applies only to CIT degree subjects. In 2011, this applies for all years in:

- Bachelor of Games and Virtual Worlds (Programming)
   FEE-HELP is available for the final (third) year subjects in:
- Bachelor of Design (Photography)
- Bachelor of Design (Fashion Design)
- Bachelor of Forensic Science (Crime Scene Examination).

## What about Certificate, Diploma and Advanced Diploma courses?

FEE-HELP does not apply to these qualifications (see VET FEE-HELP). CIT's Certificates, Diplomas and Advanced Diplomas are offered at affordable costs subsidised by the ACT Government. You can find details of these fees at <a href="https://www.cit.edu.au/future/uac">www.cit.edu.au/future/uac</a>

# I've heard about VET FEE-HELP, what is this and how is it different from FEE-HELP?

VET FEE-HELP is available through CIT for selected courses. It's similar to FEE-HELP but for Diplomas and Advanced Diplomas. Most of CIT's publicly available VET qualifications (Certificates, Diplomas and Advanced Diplomas) are offered at affordable costs subsidised by the ACT Government which is less than full cost commercial rates.

#### **How do I apply for FEE-HELP?**

- Confirm that you are an eligible student and that FEE-HELP is available for the higher education subjects (units) you wish to study.
- Check the information on FEE-HELP available from the Going to Uni website.
- If you are eligible and FEE-HELP applies to the subjects you will be studying, obtain a FEE-HELP information booklet and a Request for FEE-HELP assistance form from the CIT Student Services Hub when you enrol.
- Note the critical dates for FEE-HELP application: the Census Date is the last date you can cancel your request for FEE-HELP or withdraw from the subject without incurring a debt. Census date is also the last date you can apply for FEE-HELP if you haven't applied at registration.

#### What is a CAN?

Following the census date, CIT will send you an information notice. The Commonwealth Assistance Notice (CAN) lists the details of your registration for the semester along with your liability. It's not a bill or invoice, but the information is important as it will be sent to the Commonwealth Government so they can manage your debt. You must tell the CIT Student Services Hub immediately if there are any errors in your CAN.
